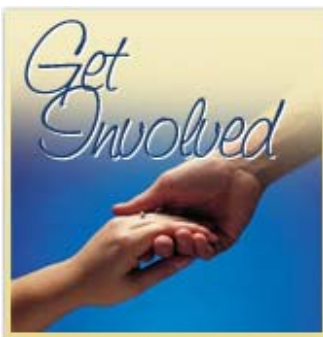

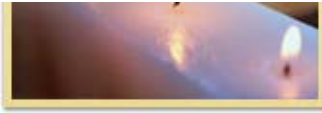

PCS Receives Grant to Help Support Child & Adolescent Services Provided by PCS

PCS is proud to announce it recently was awarded a \$5,000 grant from the Ella F. Anderson Trust, BNY Mellon, N.A., Trustee to help support its ongoing child & adolescent services. PCS provides psychotherapeutic techniques while respecting the natural connection between the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual dimensions in the psychotherapy process. At the core of PCS' mission is to provide counseling to everyone seeking assistance, because of this the provision of adjusted fee counseling services has always been a mainstay of PCS' mission.

"This grant is especially earmarked for Child & Adolescent Services provided by PCS," says David Reynolds, D.Min PCS Executive Director. "Fundraisers and contributions from individuals and congregations have often times made up the financial difference so that services can be provided to anyone requesting them," Reynolds added. "However, with the expansion of medical insurance availability in the Affordable Care Act of 2010, there has actually been in increase of adjusted fee services. The grant from Ella F. Anderson will help offset costs associated with parents and guardians of children who need counseling but cannot afford what their insurance requires them to pay as deductibles."

The grant will specifically go towards the children and adolescent services PCS provides in the Manchester and Nashua, N.H. areas.
