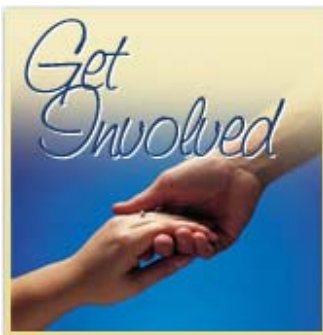

*A note from...*

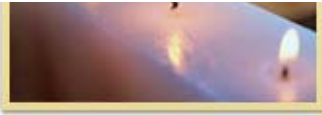
